 FRIESIAN EDUCATIONAL CLINIC BY JAN ENGELSMA
 JULY 8, 9, 2011 FOLLOWED BY AMATEUR HORSE SHOW JULY 10**

Jan Engelsma is a former FPS Board Member and former FPS judge with an expertise in linear scoring. He has inspected our Friesian horses many times in the United States and Canada during our inspection circuits. Jan is committed to sharing his extensive knowledge of the Friesian horse, the goals and directions of the mother registry, the FPS and all things Friesian with enthusiastic current and future Friesian horse owners. Jan has conducted three very successful clinics in Southern California as well as travelled to WI, TX, TN and MD.

BRING YOUR FRIESIAN --- You may bring your Friesian – mare and foal, yearlings, two year olds and mature horses, including stallions. Jan will give you an honest evaluation as to where he believes your Friesian stands in terms of quality, confirmation, movement and bloodlines. Mr. Engelsma will be looking at horses individually and possibly in an age group for a mock class, if there are enough horses in the same category.

POTENTIAL IBOP EVALUATION --- If there is interest, you may present your Friesian under saddle or in harness in order to get feedback as to their abilities in presenting an IBOP test at an inspection. You may either perform the actual test if you are prepared or just bring your horse, equipment and rider/driver and Jan will be able to give you valuable information as to how to better prepare for this experience.

AS A PARTICIPANT in the clinic, you will have an opportunity to learn the fine points of linear scoring and practice on Friesian horses under Jan's supervision. You can bring the papers of your horses and learn from Jan their history going back years in Holland and also ask for support in breeding decisions. Bring pictures and video if you like.

THESE CLINICS ARE NOT DIRECTLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE FPS, but the topics of the clinics will be consistent with, and concerned with what the FPS is doing, their direction and what is being looked for in the goals and direction of the breed. Jan will not be speaking directly or officially for the FPS but will be pulling from his years of knowledge and experience to share with all of us.
